

OverUndr Privacy Policy

OverUndr, Inc. operates a technology platform that connects independent sports analysis Creators with Users and Subscribers. This Privacy Policy explains how OverUndr collects, uses, discloses, retains, and protects personal information in connection with the Platform.

1. Scope

This Privacy Policy applies to personal information processed by OverUndr through the App, website, creator marketplace, support channels, and related services. It applies to Users, Subscribers, Creators, and visitors. Capitalized terms not defined here have the meanings in the Terms of Service.

2. Information We Collect

2.1 Information You Provide

We collect information you provide when you create an account, use the Platform, contact support, or become a Creator. This may include:

- Name, email address, username, password or authentication credentials, and account settings.
- Creator profile information, biography, images, branding materials, social links, public descriptions, pricing, tier descriptions, and Content.
- Subscriber selections, Subscription tier, account preferences, support requests, feedback, and communications with OverUndr.
- Content submitted through available Platform features, including posts, comments, messages, picks, analysis, links, uploaded materials, screenshots, and profile materials.

2.2 Creator Onboarding and Payout Information

Creators may be required to complete identity, tax, payout, sanctions, fraud, or compliance screening through a Payment Processor or verification provider. Those third parties may collect personal information, tax information, bank information, or identity documents. OverUndr generally receives limited verification status, payout status, tax status, compliance signals, transaction information, and related records. OverUndr does not intend to store full bank account numbers or full payment-card numbers.

2.3 Payment and Transaction Information

When a User purchases a Subscription, sends a payment, receives a refund, or receives a Creator payout, OverUndr or its Payment Processors may process transaction information such as product, tier, amount, currency, transaction ID, renewal status, cancellation status, refund status, chargeback status, app store receipt information, billing country or zip code, tax information, and payment-channel metadata. Full payment credentials are processed by the applicable Payment Processor.

2.4 Automatically Collected Information

When you use the Platform, OverUndr and its service providers may collect device, usage, and diagnostic information, such as IP address, device identifiers, app version, operating system, browser type, pages or screens viewed, session information, crash logs, referral information,

timestamps, feature interactions, and approximate location derived from IP address or device settings.

2.5 Cookies, Pixels, and Similar Technologies

On the website, OverUndr and its service providers may use cookies, pixels, local storage, or similar technologies to operate the website, remember preferences, analyze usage, prevent fraud, and improve performance. The App may use device identifiers, SDKs, or similar technologies for analytics, security, diagnostics, push notifications, payments, or account functionality where enabled.

2.6 Push Notifications

If push notifications are enabled and you consent, OverUndr may process device tokens and notification preferences to deliver service messages, creator updates, or other notifications. You can manage push notifications through device settings or in-app settings where available.

2.7 Information from Third Parties

OverUndr may receive information from Payment Processors, app stores, authentication providers, analytics providers, verification providers, hosting providers, security vendors, and other service providers that support the Platform.

3. How We Use Information

OverUndr uses personal information to:

- Create, authenticate, maintain, and secure accounts.
- Provide the App, Subscriptions, Creator pages, Content access, community features, support, and Platform functionality.
- Process purchases, renewals, cancellations, refunds, chargebacks, taxes, Creator payouts, and payment disputes.
- Verify Creators, prevent fraud, enforce payment rules, and comply with processor or app store obligations.
- Monitor, moderate, investigate, and enforce the Terms of Service, Acceptable Use Policy, and other policies.
- Detect, prevent, and respond to fraud, abuse, security incidents, illegal activity, and harmful conduct.
- Communicate service updates, account notices, policy changes, security alerts, billing notices, and support responses.
- Send marketing communications where permitted by law and your choices.
- Improve, test, debug, analyze, and develop the Platform.
- Generate aggregated or de-identified information that does not reasonably identify you.
- Comply with legal obligations, law enforcement requests, legal process, tax obligations, and dispute-resolution needs.

4. How We Share Information

OverUndr may share personal information as described below.

4.1 Creators and Subscribers

If you subscribe to a Creator, the Creator may receive limited information needed to provide the Subscription and understand their audience, such as username, display name, subscription status, tier, interaction information, and messages or comments you submit to that Creator. Creators are responsible for their own handling of information they receive through the Platform and must comply with the Terms of Service and Platform policies.

4.2 Service Providers

OverUndr may share information with vendors and service providers that help operate the Platform, including hosting, payments, app stores, identity verification, analytics, security, communications, customer support, tax, fraud prevention, and infrastructure providers.

4.3 Payment Processors and App Stores

Payment Processors and app stores process payments, refunds, cancellations, renewal status, subscription events, chargebacks, fraud signals, and receipts under their own terms and privacy policies. Apple-billed purchases are managed through Apple. Web or Stripe-billed purchases are managed through the applicable web payment flow or Payment Processor.

4.4 Legal, Safety, and Compliance

OverUndr may disclose information where reasonably necessary to comply with law, legal process, tax obligations, payment-processor requirements, app store requirements, or law enforcement requests, or to protect the rights, safety, property, users, staff, Creators, Subscribers, or Platform integrity of OverUndr or others.

4.5 Business Transfers

If OverUndr is involved in a merger, acquisition, financing, restructuring, bankruptcy, sale of assets, or similar transaction, personal information may be transferred as part of that transaction subject to applicable law.

4.6 Aggregated or De-Identified Information

OverUndr may share aggregated or de-identified information that does not reasonably identify you.

5. Sale, Sharing, and Targeted Advertising

OverUndr does not sell personal information for money. If OverUndr engages in activity that applicable privacy law defines as a "sale," "sharing," or "targeted advertising," OverUndr will provide required notices and opt-out choices.

6. Your Choices and Rights

Depending on where you live, you may have rights to request access, correction, deletion, portability, restriction, objection, or appeal regarding certain personal information. You may exercise rights by emailing team@overundrapp.com. OverUndr may verify your identity before responding. OverUndr will not discriminate against you for exercising privacy rights.

You may opt out of marketing emails by using the unsubscribe link. If OverUndr offers SMS marketing and you consent, you may opt out by replying STOP. You can manage cookies through browser settings and push notifications through device settings.

7. Account Deletion

You may request deletion of your account through the App where available or by emailing team@overundrapp.com. Deleting your OverUndr account does not automatically cancel Apple-billed subscriptions. You must cancel Apple-billed subscriptions through your Apple account settings. OverUndr may retain records after deletion where reasonably necessary for transactions, tax, accounting, fraud prevention, chargebacks, refunds, safety, moderation, legal compliance, dispute resolution, enforcement, audits, backups, and legitimate business operations.

8. Data Retention

OverUndr retains personal information for as long as reasonably necessary for the purposes described in this Privacy Policy, including providing the Platform, maintaining accounts, processing transactions, complying with law, preventing fraud, resolving disputes, enforcing agreements, and maintaining business records. Retention periods vary depending on the type of information, sensitivity, legal requirements, payment or tax obligations, security needs, and user choices.

9. Security

OverUndr uses reasonable administrative, technical, and physical safeguards designed to protect personal information. No system, transmission, or storage method is completely secure. You are responsible for maintaining the security of your account credentials.

10. Children and Minors

The Platform is intended for Users who are at least 18 years old. OverUndr does not knowingly collect personal information from minors. If OverUndr learns that a minor has created an account or provided personal information, OverUndr will take appropriate steps to delete or restrict the account and associated information, subject to legal and safety retention needs.

11. International Data Processing

OverUndr is based in the United States. Information may be processed in the United States or other jurisdictions where OverUndr or its service providers operate. Those jurisdictions may have privacy laws different from your location.

12. Third-Party Links and Services

The Platform may link to or integrate third-party services. OverUndr is not responsible for the privacy practices, content, security, or policies of third parties. You should review third-party privacy policies before using those services.

13. Do Not Track

Some browsers offer "Do Not Track" signals. Because there is no uniform industry standard for these signals, OverUndr does not currently respond to them. OverUndr will honor legally required opt-out preference signals where applicable and technically feasible.

14. California and Nevada Privacy Notices

California residents may have rights under California privacy laws, including rights to know, access, delete, correct, and opt out of certain sharing. Nevada residents may request to opt out of certain sales of covered information. OverUndr does not currently sell personal information for money. Requests may be submitted to team@overundrapp.com.

15. Changes to This Privacy Policy

OverUndr may update this Privacy Policy from time to time. If changes are material, OverUndr will provide notice as required by law. Continued use of the Platform after an updated policy becomes effective means you acknowledge the updated policy.
